tasting notes:

Not content with crafting the finest Riesling, the Keller family are also rather adept with Burgundy varietals. This Weisser Burgunder (Pinot Blanc) & Chardonnay is Felix Keller's take on white Burgundy utilising grapes from across Dalsheim. Previously this blend was equal parts Pinot Blanc and Chardonnay, however 2021 comes in at 70% Pinot Blanc and 30% Chardonnay. The wine is raised in larger 300 litre barrels that Felix purchased from Dagneau and Lalou Bize-Leroy at d'Auvenay, along with some stainless steel.
