Cabernet Sauvignon (58%), Cabernet Franc (13%), Merlot (11%), Petit Verdot (10%), Malbec (8%). Beautiful perfume of dried flowers, sweet tobacco and spice, blackcurrant and redcurrant, even almond meal. Dense and dark, with a smattering of dried herb, ripe cherry, crisp acidity, firm grainy tannin, and a distinctly 'mineral' and savoury finish of exemplary length. It's a textbook example of superb Yarra Valley Cabernet. *Gary Walsh - Wine Front.*
